It is important to be able to feel safe and happy in your home.

We can help you find a home that suits your support needs. We can also help you find a home near where you want to live.

You have a choice on who you live with in your home.



We do lots of things to make sure your home is good for Some of these are:

We work with you, the important people in your life, your support coordinator and your Supported Independent Living (SIL) service provider.



We make sure you have the information that you need and want. We find out what your support and accessibility needs are, the areas you'd like to live and the types of people you'd like to live with. Then we match that with properties we have available.



We will help you find and look at properties you like and to meet any new housemates.

What If I Don't Like My Home?



Sometimes, you may not be happy in your home. This could be for many reasons.

You might not like the people you live with. Your support needs might change. You might not feel safe.



If you are not happy in your home, please tell us. We might be able to change some things you are not happy with.



If you decide to move from your home, you may have to review your NDIS plan. The National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) make the decision on Specialist Disability Accommodation being included in your plan. However, Hume will support you in the process.

How will I be involved?



Decisions about your housing and tenancy will not be made without you involved.

We apply a supported decision-making approach to help if you need additional support in making decisions about your housing needs.



You will be involved in the decision making when someone is looking to move into your home.

When you are moving home, you or your guardian will be included in meetings that discuss what your housing choices and support needs are.



You have a right to move out of your home if you choose, and we will help you to do so.
